Owego TV pioneer getting arts award

Ralph Hocking, founding director of the Experimental Television Center Ltd. in Owego, will be one of four recipients tonight when the New York Foundation for the Arts presents its annual Champion of the Arts awards.

Hocking will be honored as a pioneer in experimental video art.

"For almost two decades, he has provided artists with the time and space and innovative material with which to create their art," said Holly Blasier, special events coordinator for the not-for-profit foundation.
